**APPOINTMENTS**

All consultations with a GP or **Treatment Room** are by appointment. These can be made by calling at reception or by telephone. Please make a separate appointment for each person. Patients may express a preference of practitioner when requesting an appointment. We will try to accommodate such requests to allow patients to see the GP of their choice.

**HOUSE CALLS**

If you are too ill to come to the surgery a home visit can be requested by telephone, when the receptionist will ask you to provide details of your symptoms. Requests for house calls should be made, whenever possible, **before 10am**, so that unnecessary delays are prevented.

**PLEASE DO NOT ABUSE THIS SERVICE**, as it is reserved for chronically ill patients and in cases of medical emergency. If you are able to come to the surgery please do so as this saves time for both patient & Doctor.

**REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS**

Prescriptions may be requested by telephone or alternatively by post. Requests should be made 48 hours in advance and prescriptions will be ready for collection after 2pm the day after they are ordered.

**TELEPHONE ADVICE**

You may telephone and speak to anyone at the Practice for advice. The doctors are usually available between 8.30 am and 10.30am. Mornings only for routine calls. The receptionist will ask you for a contact number and short note of what it is regarding and add you to the telephone list. **THE LIST CLOSES 10.30AM**

**ASTHMA CLINIC**

An asthma clinic is carried out by a fully trained Nurse. Appointments can be made by telephone or at Reception.

**CERVICAL SMEAR/  
WELL WOMAN CLINIC**

The Practice is keen to promote prevention of women's diseases. It is important therefore, that a cervical smear is carried out every 3 to 5 years. The Doctors are available to carry out smears.

**FAMILY PLANNING**

Advice on family planning is available by appointment. All our doctors provide contraception treatment and advice.

**MINOR SURGERY**

Minor surgery is provided by all our doctors.

**Regular Check-ups**

A medical check or assessment can be offered to all patients over the age of 75 years who have not had a consultation in the last three years.
